



Its Chinese daughter company QuaTerNes Agricultural Science & Technology Tianjin Co. Ltd. in Beichen, Tianjin has offices with dedicated agronomists, engineers and food experts present. It offers full-scale local services in Research & Development and in design and (turnkey) realization.



Based on its experience gained in the past thirty years, many successful ventures have been established and direct deliveries made. QuaTerNes is currently involved in several large-scale development projects. These include the HakHandan Industrial Park, the Yakeshi Agro-Food Logistic Center, investments in potato seed multiplication laboratories (Ilan Bio), the realization of potato processing factories and the production of agricultural machinery (HAKING). 

Company history & interview with

Jan Hak, founder of QuaTerNes, has been familiar with the agri-food chain from an early age. After graduating from Wageningen University he started his professional career in the pickling and dairy sectors in the Middle East, after which he played a significant role in food machinery development (Komen+Kuin) and was responsible for the manufacturing and logistics at his family's food preservation company (HAK). His experiences lead to the start of his own company in 1980.

Today, QuaTerNes integrates a portfolio of companies. Together they manage and advise development and investment projects in the agriculture and food sectors worldwide.

Jan Hak: "Our mission is to facilitate the development of secure and sustainable agrifood chains, supporting local agri-food systems and nourish partnerships and agri-food related initiatives".

A century of experience...

Jan Hak: "I come from the region of Altena, a longtime isolated region where communities made their living with fishing, osier working, cattle and arable farming. It is here where our history begins and where our roots are still visible today".




In the 1920's, his great grandparents were active in growing and trade of fruit and potato. Jan: "They started a door-to-door service that developed into transport via horse drawn wagons. Later on, they also opened fixed stores. Many products were homemade such as liquors and applesauce. All of this occurred before World War II."

In 1952 the food rationing finally ended and the HAK family was able to expand its production. This lead to the opening of their first canning factory in Giessen, a small village with only 900 inhabitants. The company continued to grow as more and more shops, groceries and butchers started selling HAK glass preserved vegetables. Presently, HAK is one of the largest producers of high quality fruit and vegetable glass preserves worldwide.

Jan: "My education contributed directly to the expanding of knowledge within the family company. As part of my studies 'Food Technology' and 'Business Administration' at Wageningen University in The Netherlands, I have also spent time studying abroad under renowned professors in the USA and the Middle East. Later on, I gained practical experience by realizing turnkey processing facilities and innovative technologies such as steam peeling, dry de-skinning, osmotic drying, vacuum frying and cold-infusion. Many references worldwide are a direct proof of success".
